ORDINANCE ON REWARDING STUDENTS

Rijeka, January 2021

Based on article 26 of the Statute of the Faculty of Dental Medicine of the University of Rijeka Class: 003-01/20-03/02 Number: 2170-57-01-20-80 of 31st March 2020 and the Decision on the acceptance of the Statute Class: 011-01/20-01/10 Number: 2170-57-006-20-1 of the 28th May 2020, the Faculty Council on January 21st 2021 presents

Ordinance on rewarding students

Article 1.

This Ordinance determines the criteria and method of awarding the best full-time students, graduates of doctoral studies of dental medicine, and graduates of bachelor's degrees, on the occasion of Faculty Day.

Article 2.

Every academic year, on the occasion of Faculty Day, the Dean's Award for academic success is awarded. The goal of the Dean's Award for academic success is to encourage students to achieve greater success in their studies.

Article 3.

The Dean's Award for academic success is awarded to the best students of integrated studies 1,2,3,4 and 5th year, or for undergraduate studies in 1st and 2nd years of study.

The Dean's Award for academic success is awarded to graduates of doctoral studies of dental medicine and graduates of bachelor's degrees for overall success in studies.

Article 4.

As a rule, one award can be awarded for graduated doctors of dental medicine according to the criteria of clinical subjects in agreement with KBC Rijeka.

Article 5.

Criteria for awarding the Dean's Award:

- Nominees for the award for individual years of study must be regularly enrolled in the following year, without having repeated the year during their studies, must have achieved all ECTS credits with a success rate of at least 4.00 from all passed exams and at least 4.50 in the subject of the year for which they are rewarded,
- Nominees for the award based on the entire course of study - graduate doctors of dental medicine and graduates of bachelor's degrees must have an average grade from all years of study of at least 4.50, a thesis grade of at least 4.00, and the length of the studies is also taken as a criterion.
- Nominees for the award based on the criterion of clinical courses must have an average grade of at least 4.50 in the 4th, 5th and 6th years of study (without electives).
- Nominees will also be awarded points for socially useful work - volunteering, professional volunteering, participation in the work of the student newspaper, publication of scientific or

professional works, top artistic achievements, representations in sports. The applicants must prove the above with a written confirmation.

The final number of nominees for the award is determined by the Decision of the Vice Dean for Teaching and Business, based on data on average grades and duration of studies obtained from the Office for Student Affairs, immediately after enrolment in the next academic year. The vice dean for teaching and business will fill out the student evaluation table which is attached to this Ordinance for each nominee in order to be selected for the dean's award.

Article 6.

Every year, the Dean can award one or more special awards of the Dean's Office to a student or a group of students, regardless of grade point average, for exceptional success in scientific work (work published in journals with international peer review), public performance or action (international competitions, volunteering, humanitarian work, artistic or sports achievements, student associations or the like).

Article 7.

The decision on the winners of the Dean's award for academic success are published on the website of the Faculty of Dental medicine and are placed in the student's file.

Article 8.

The content and form of the written acknowledgment is determined by the dean. In addition to the written recognition, an appropriate cash prize can be awarded in accordance with the Faculty's available funds, and the amount of the cash prize is determined by the Dean's department. The awards are presented by the dean, or departmental vice-dean, at the General Session of the Faculty Council on the occasion of Faculty Day.

Article 9.

The ordinance enters into effect on the day of publication. The ordinance will be published on the website of the Faculty.
