



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Academic year 2026/2027

Republic of Croatia, University of Rijeka, Faculty of Dental Medicine hereby announces the Call for Applications for enrollment in the first year of University Integrated Undergraduate and Graduate Study of Dental Medicine (in English) for the Academic year 2026/2027.

1. Study Program

On 1st February 2026 applications are open for the study program Dental Medicine in English language

Dental Medicine in English is University integrated undergraduate and graduate study, with a 6-year duration. The academic year starts in October and admission is possible only into the winter semester.

2. Number of available places

The maximum number of admitted students will be 12 and all the admitted students are expected to pay the tuition fee in the amount of 12.000,00 Euro per academic year.

3. Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following general requirements:

- Completed at least four-year high school education or its equivalent and final high school examinations
- Taking Chemistry, Biology and Physics for at least two years during high school education or its equivalent
- Candidates must pass Entrance exam and Psychomotor Ability Test

4. Selection Criteria

Candidates will be ranked based on:

- Evaluation of secondary school grades – **20 %**
- Entrance exam results – **60 %**
- Psychomotor Ability Test – **20%**



5. Application Period

Applications for the summer term should be sent by **June 15, 2026**

Applications for the summer term should be sent by **August 21, 2026**.

The fall term will be offered only if there are available places left.

Final date for sending application for candidates who finished their secondary education abroad before December 31, 2025 is April 30, 2026.

Incomplete and late applications and applications sent by e-mail or fax will not be considered.

6. Application Procedure

Applicants must apply for study programme:

- through the national application system at www.postani-student.hr and
- by submitting application directly to the Faculty of Dental Medicine.

Applicants must submit the following documents:

1. Completed application form
2. Originals or certified copies of secondary school certificates (for all the years of secondary school) with an official transcript of grades.
3. Final high school report card – final certificate of education
4. Certificates of higher courses or degrees (college/university) if applicable
5. English translation of secondary school/ graduation certificates if these have not been originally written in English or Croatian.
6. Curriculum vitae in English (Europass)
7. 2 photographs, 4×6 cm (not older than six months)
8. Proof of payment of Application fee in the amount of €250
9. Original or certified copy of the birth certificate and the proof of citizenship (rodni list, domovnica and validated copy of your ID card or passport)
10. Statement of financial support
11. Applicants must provide proof of English language proficiency certificate (TOEFL, IELTS). Cambridge and Oxford English language exams and certificates issued by (foreign) language schools (B2 level) are also accepted, as well as certificates of English language proficiency issued by a secondary school a candidate attended.

Important:

High school certificates and graduation certificates published in a foreign language, must be accompanied by a translation of that same document into Croatian or English language validated by a certified court interpreter. Copies of documents must be certified by a public notary.

Validated copies of report cards in Serbian, Montenegrin or Bosnian Latin script, as well as those in English do not need to be translated by a certified court interpreter, but must only be validated by a public notary.

7. Entrance exam

The entrance exam consists of a test in Biology, Chemistry and Physics (120 multiple-choice questions, with 40 questions from each subject).

Entrance exam will be organized on-site on Faculty of Dental Medicine on following dates:

- June 30, 2026
- September 1, 2026

The overall minimum score is 30%.

8. Psychomotor Ability Test

Psychomotor Ability Test is used for determining the precision, coordination, control, dexterity and reaction time of candidates.

Psychomotor Ability Test will be held online on following dates:

- July 1, 2026
- September 2, 2026



9. Results and Enrollment

The preliminary results of the entrance exam and psychomotor ability test will be published on official website of Faculty of Dental Medicine.

The final ranking list will be published on National Information System for Application to Higher Education Institutions (NISaHEI/NISpVU) at <https://www.postani-student.hr/Ucenici/Prijava.aspx>.

When the final ranking list is published, candidates who are ranked within the quota and have received an enrolment number are eligible to enrol in the study program. Enrolment will be held online on following dates:

- Summer term: July 22, 2026
- Fall term: September 23, 2026

Enrolment is only valid for one academic year at a time.

10. Tuition fees

- The tuition fee for admitted students costs €12,000 per academic year
- The cost of the application fee is €250
- The cost of enrolment fee for the academic year 2026/2027 should be approximately €60

The academic year starts in October and admission is possible only into the winter semester. The tuition fee can be paid in full at enrolment or in two instalments (€6,000 at enrolment, €6,000 by November 15, 2026).

11. Additional Information

Students will be required to demonstrate knowledge of the Croatian language as specified in the study contract. They must achieve a B1 level of proficiency in Croatian by the time they enrol in their fourth year of study.

Candidates who completed their high school education abroad must have their high school diploma recognized in Croatia to be eligible for enrollment.

The procedure of recognition of foreign high school qualifications, which is part of general or gymnasium study programs with the purpose of continuation of education is run by the **Agency for Science and Higher Education**. Recognition of foreign secondary education qualification can be processed only as part of central admissions system, meaning candidates must register into the system on the website www.postani-student.hr.
