SYLLABUS

Information about the course (brief description of the course, general instructions, where and in what form classes are organized, necessary supplies, instructions on attendance, and preparation for classes, student obligations, etc.):

Endodontics I is an obligatory course in the fifth year of the Integrated undergraduate and graduate University Study Programme in Dental Medicine. The course comprises 10 hours of lectures, 10 hours of seminars, and 90 hours of practical exercises, for a total workload of 110 contact hours (6 ECTS credits).

The course covers the diagnosis and management of all inflammatory, traumatic, and degenerative conditions affecting the dental pulp and the associated periapical tissues. It aims to provide students with knowledge of developmental and morphological anomalies of the endodontic space, pathological conditions of the pulp and periapical tissues, and their diagnosis and treatment. Students will become familiar with the properties and clinical application of endodontic materials, techniques of root canal instrumentation and obturation, and post-endodontic restoration of teeth. The course also includes the diagnosis and treatment of endodontic–periodontal lesions, as well as the principles and procedures of endodontic surgery.

Attendance at all forms of teaching is mandatory. Before seminars and practical sessions, students are expected to prepare by studying the topics covered in the lectures. Students who have not demonstrated adequate theoretical knowledge will not be permitted to perform practical work on preclinical models or provide treatment to patients.

Learning outcome: Describe the design, properties, and clinical applications of nickel–titanium instruments used for mechanical root canal preparation.

Learning outcome: Analyze the principles and objectives of mechanical root canal preparation and apply appropriate instrumentation techniques.

L3 Intracanal Medicaments in Endodontics

Learning outcome: Select and apply appropriate local anaesthetic techniques for endodontic procedures.

L6 Tooth Bleaching

Learning outcome: Explain the indications, techniques, and limitations of vital and non-vital tooth bleaching.

L7 Failures and Complications of Endodontic Treatment

Learning outcome: Identify the causes of endodontic treatment failure and recognize common procedural complications.

L8 Endodontic Retreatment

Learning outcome: Describe the indications, principles, and clinical procedures involved in non-surgical endodontic retreatment.

L9 Tooth Resorption and Bioceramic Materials in Endodontics

Learning outcome: Classify different types of tooth resorption and explain the clinical applications of bioceramic materials in endodontic treatment.

L10 Post-Endodontic Restoration of Teeth

Learning outcome: Select appropriate post-endodontic restorative strategies to ensure the long-term function and survival of endodontically treated teeth.



List of seminars (with titles and explanations):

S1 Cone Beam Computed Tomography (CBCT) in Endodontics

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to explain the indications, advantages, and limitations of CBCT in endodontic diagnosis and treatment planning, and apply current guidelines for its appropriate use.

S2 Use of Antibiotics and Pain Management in Endodontics

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to critically evaluate the indications for antibiotic prescription and select appropriate pharmacological strategies for pain and infection management.

S3 Management of Complex Root Canal Anatomy

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to recognize anatomical variations of the root canal system and select appropriate strategies for their clinical management.

S4 Management of Endodontic Emergencies

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to diagnose common endodontic emergencies, prioritize treatment, and select appropriate emergency interventions.

S5 Contemporary Irrigation and Disinfection Protocols

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to compare irrigation solutions, activation techniques, and disinfection protocols and justify their clinical use based on current evidence.

S6 Prevention and Management of Procedural Errors

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to identify procedural errors during endodontic treatment, assess their clinical significance, and propose appropriate management strategies.

S7 Modern Endodontic Materials: Bioceramics

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to compare contemporary endodontic materials, evaluate their biological and mechanical properties, and select appropriate clinical indications.

S8 Endodontic Retreatment

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to identify the indications for nonsurgical endodontic retreatment, describe retreatment techniques, and evaluate factors affecting treatment outcomes.

S9 Regenerative Endodontics and Vital Pulp Therapy

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to explain the biological principles, indications, and clinical procedures of regenerative endodontic treatment and vital pulp therapy, and evaluate their role in contemporary endodontics.

S10 Artificial Intelligence and Digital Technologies in Endodontics

Learning outcomes: Students will be able to evaluate the applications, benefits, and limitations of artificial intelligence, digital imaging, and guided endodontics in diagnosis and treatment planning.

List of practicals (with titles and explanations):

Learning outcomes:



Analyze anamnestic data and act therapeutically in accordance with them (risk patients, etc. prophylaxis, pregnant women, etc.)
Analyze (diagnose) diseases of the pulp and periapical periodontium
Interpret diagnostic procedures and their importance
Based on the diagnostic data, evaluate (set) the diagnosis and determine the therapy (therapy of pulp and periapical periodontal disease)
Explain the morphology of the endodontic space of an individual tooth
Establish a dry working field
Perform individual phases of endodontic therapy (access cavity, root canal instrumentation, root canal filling)
Use and differentiate endodontic instruments
Handle dental materials and apply them in accordance with the indication
Analyze the CBCT image / make a diagnosis

Student obligations:

Students are required to regularly attend and actively participate in all forms of teaching. Attendance at lectures, seminars, and practical exercises is mandatory. A student may miss up to 20% of classes solely for health reasons (justified by a medical certificate) or a death in the family.

Participation in preclinical and clinical practical sessions requires wearing a white medical uniform (in accordance with the regulations of the healthcare institution and Article 5 of the Code of Conduct for Students of the Faculty of Dental Medicine, University of Rijeka). The instructor may remove a student from the practical session if the student is not appropriately dressed or behaves inappropriately.

Exam (method of taking the exam, description of the written/oral/practical part of the exam, method of scoring, assessment criteria):

Student assessment is conducted in accordance with the current **University of Rijeka Study Regulations**. Student performance is assessed continuously throughout the course and by means of a final examination upon completion of the course. Completion of all course requirements is a prerequisite for taking the final examination. The final examination is written and consists of either open-ended questions or multiple-choice questions.

Final Grade Calculation: The final grade is based on the average performance in the practical coursework and seminars (50% of the final grade), together with the result of the final examination (50% of the final grade). Out of a total of 100 grading points, students may earn up to 30 points for practical work in the practical sessions, 20 points for seminars, and up to 50 points for the final examination.



Participation in practical classes and seminars is graded as follows:

Student assessment is conducted using the ECTS (A–F) and numerical (5–1) systems as follows: A (5) – 90–100 grade points; B (4) – 75–89.99 grade points; C (3) – 60–74.99 grade points; D (2) – 50–59.99 grade points; F (1) – 0–49.99 grade points.

Teachers will assess both the students' theoretical knowledge and their practical performance on patients. During the practical sessions, each student is required to independently complete the assigned stages of treatment, which are graded on a scale of A–C, where grade C represents an unsatisfactory performance. If a student receives two grade C evaluations during the academic year, it is considered that they have not fulfilled the required practical course obligations (i.e., they have not achieved the minimum passing threshold of 50%) and therefore are not eligible to enroll in the next year of study.

Seminars are an active component of the course and require mandatory theoretical preparation. Each student must deliver one presentation and/or oral seminar before the final examination.

The final examination is in a form of written examination.

Students are required to bring their completed Record Book of Clinical Practicals to the final examination. If a student fails the final examination, they are entitled to take the examination at the next available examination period, which must be at least 15 days after the previous examination date.

Grading according to the ECTS grading system is based on absolute achievement, as follows:

- Points earned through practical sessions and the midterm examination are added to the points earned on the final examination.
- Final grade:
 - 0–49.9% – Fail (1, F)
 - 50–59.9% – Sufficient (2, D)
 - 60–74.9% – Good (3, C)



- 75–89.9% – Very Good (4, B)
- 90–100% – Excellent (5, A)

Other notes (related to the course) important for students:
